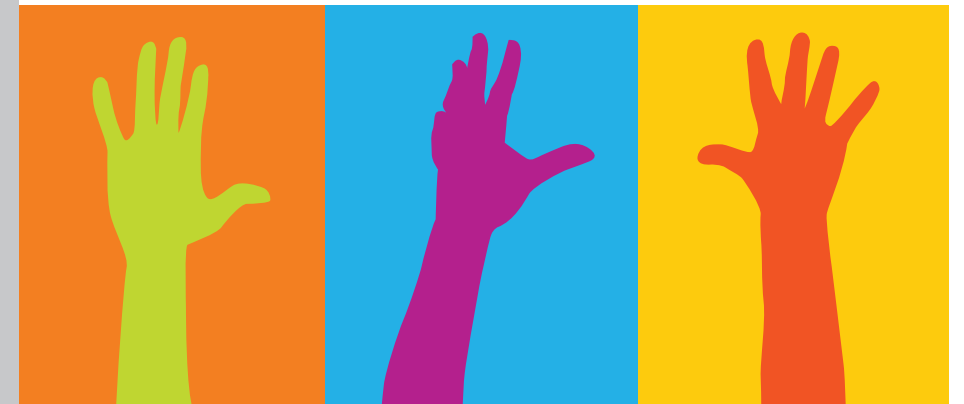

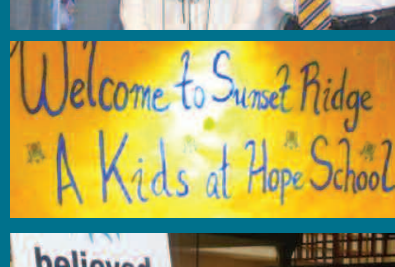

Dr. Nel Noddings, Int'l Renowned Education Philosopher and Author to Speak at 2010 Youth Development Master's Institute



Dr. Nel Noddings will be the Kids at Hope 2010 National Youth Development Master's Institute Keynote Speaker and featured workshop presenter. Professor Noddings is the Lee L. Jacks Professor of Education, Emerita, at Stanford University. In addition to thirteen books - among them *Happiness and Education* and *The Challenge to Care in Education*-she is the author of some 200 articles and chapters on various topics. She was the Director of the Laboratory Schools at the University of Chicago. At Stanford she received the award for Teaching Excellence on three different occasions. She also served as Associate Dean and as Acting Dean while at Stanford.
